Here are some general guidelines on how to lay out references for publication in the Pharmaceutical Journal: Authors should focus on recent papers and papers older than five years should not be included except for an overriding purpose. Primary literature references, and any patents or websites, should be numerically listed in the reference section in the order that they occur in the text (including any references that only appear in figures/tables/boxes) using ...

When to reference Whenever you use an idea from someone else's work, for example from a journal article, textbook or website, you should cite the original author to make it clear where that idea came from. This is the case regardless of whether you have paraphrased, summarised or directly quoted their work.

In the reference list add the name of the person and telephone number or and/or e-mail address to make it possible for other persons to contact your source. Examples: Daly, B. Länsstyrelsen, Skåne, 040-XXXXXX.

In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.
