Authors Preface It is impossible for a man to learn, what he thinks he already knows! Most Americans believe that the U.S Government is protecting privacy rights and private property. The sad truth is, through the Act of 1871, and HJR 192, our government has abandoned its' duty to the supreme office holder, the sovereign Citizen.
