God's blessing is declared on those who walk according to this rule (among the Galatians who were Gentiles), and also "upon the Israel of God." The use of "Israel of God" is difficult to explain apart from the intention of the writer to set off the "Israel of God" from those considered in the first half of the verse.

A noted Old Testament scholar offers this vivid look at Israel -- its land, people, worship, lifestyles, and future -- with special attention to questions about the current and future Israeli state.

LaRondelle allows the Bible to act as its own expositor by pointing to the New Testament as the basis for prophetic interpretation. Attention is given to the Old Testament prophecies concerning Israel and how the New Testament prophecies do not support the dispensationalist view.

George Lindbeck lamented that his most widely read work, *The Nature of Doctrine*, had often been read apart from his ecumenical focus. In this book, Shaun Brown seeks to provide a corrective to misreadings

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of Lindbeck's work by focusing upon his Israelology his emphasis upon the church and Israel as one elect people of God. While many Christians after the Holocaust have noted the harm that supersessionism brought to the Jews, Lindbeck focuses upon the harm that supersessionism has brought to the church. He argues the appropriation of Israelhood by the church can bring intra-Christian ecumenical benefits. This work comes in two stages. In the first stage, undertaken while he was an observer at the Second Vatican Council, Lindbeck discusses a parallel between Israel and the church. The second stage, which begins in the late 1980s and continues through the end of his career, Lindbeck describes the church as Israel-like or As Israel. Shaun C. According to the Bible, who really is the "Israel of God" (Galatians 6:16)? The name Israel was first mentioned in Genesis 32 when Jacob wrestled with the Lord and the Lord said to Jacob, "Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed" (Genesis 32:28). Jacob had a character change. He went from a deceiver, supplanter, and trickster to a prince with God and a champion of God. Therefore, Israel is a spiritual term that lies deep in the heart of God that defines His changed people. They are God's holy people made up of every tribe, tongue, and nation who have been washed in the blood of Jesus and now have been transformed into the sons of the Living God. This revelation is a must for all believers because this is God's promise for His people. This is His emphasis in the last days. He died to deliver us from the Law which envelops all of Jewish tradition, customs, and ordinances, which "gendereth to bondage" (Galatians 4:24). For through Jesus "there is neither Jew nor Greek" and we now are all God's new creation created in Christ Jesus. This is the Israel of God!
